The physical measurement and physical efficiency test will be held in the aforesaid locations w.e.f. **06.08.2018 (Monday) at 7.00AM**. The candidates are requested to be present in their respective venues at the date and time fixed. The aforesaid examination may continue for a long period. Hence, the candidates are required to come prepared to stay for a few days. If at any point of time the candidate disqualifies, he/she shall not proceed to the next stage.

3. Terms and condition of service

The appointment to the posts shall be made initially on contractual basis on consolidated monthly remuneration. The conditions of service and the tenure of the contractual appointment to the posts will be regulated by the Odisha Group-C and

Group-D posts (Contractual Appointment) Rules, 2013 and subsequent Government instructions and amendments thereon.

4. Examination Fees

Without Bank Draft/Postal Order, the application will be rejected. The SC/ST Candidates are exempted from paying the examination fees.

5. Registration of Name in Employment Exchange

A candidate should have registered his/her name in any one of the Employment Exchanges of the concerned district (for which he/she applies for the post of Civil Constables) before publication of the advertisement for recruitment. A candidate should not register his/her name in more than one Employment Exchange. The Home Guards and Group-D employees working in the Police Department and Ex-Servicemen need not register their names in any Employment Exchange. The candidates belonging to SC / ST applying to any District other than his / her own districts should register their names in the Special Employment Exchange, Bhubaneswar.

6. Age limit

The age of the candidates should not be less than 18 years and more than 23 years as on 01.01.2018 (**upper age relaxation in case of SC, ST & SEBC candidates and all categories of women candidate is up to 5 years**). The age limit for Ex-Servicemen shall be relaxed as per the Government Rules. The Home Guard candidates who intend to apply for the post of Civil Constables in District/Establishment, should not be more than 28 years of age as on 01.01.2018. Similarly, the candidates belonging to Group-D in the Police Department, should not be more than 43 years of age as on 01.01.2018. **The candidates shall avail only one benefit as indicated above.**

7. Qualification

Candidate must have **passed +2 examination** or equivalent examination conducted by the Council of Higher Secondary Education, Odisha or by any other recognized Board / Council. A candidate should be able to speak, read and write Odia and must have passed Odia as one of the subjects in the High School Certificate Examination or an examination in Odia Language equivalent to M.E standard, recognized or conducted by the School and Mass Education Department of Government of Odisha.

8. Other eligibility criteria

- A candidate must be of good character.
- If married, the candidate must not have more than one spouse living.

- c. A candidate must be of sound health, free from organic defects and any physical deformity.
- d. A Group-D employee working in Police Department must have completed 5 years of continuous service and have good service record without any major punishment. The applications of Group D employees of Police Department shall be forwarded by the Heads of office.
- e. A Home Guard candidate must have completed 3 years of enrolment without any interruption on the date on which the advertisement for recruitment is published and must have undergone the basic course of training for Home Guards. The application of Home Guards shall be forwarded by the Heads of Office.

N.B.:-The candidates are required to produce original certificates of his / her educational qualifications for verification by the Board at any time during the recruitment process. If any candidate fails to produce the required certificates, he/she shall be disqualified and the candidate shall not be allowed to participate in the further recruitment process. Besides, at any point of time, if the Board feels that the candidate does not possess the requisite qualification for the post of Civil Constable in the Districts/Establishments, at that particular point of time, his / her candidature shall be disqualified. - (i) Relaxation in the physical standard for Group-D employees for re-musteration in the rank of Constable will be allowed as follows:-
Height- 3 Cm, Weight-5 Kg, Chest- 2 Cm.

Such relaxation will be availed by the Group-D employees in respect of the physical standards prescribed for their respective categories (UR,SEBC,SC,ST)

- (ii) The deficiencies of a Sports person, who is deficient in his/her physical standards of measurements by 3 cm in height, 2 cm in chest and 5 Kg in weight for his/her candidature for appointment to the post of Constables will be relaxed provided he/she has represented the State in a National level sports and games meet. For such representation in sports and games, only the certification from the Directorate of sports shall be considered.

11. Driving Test:- Allotted Marks:05

The test shall be conducted only for those candidates who claim in their applications that they are proficient in driving and possesses either Light or Heavy Vehicle Driving license for the last six months(excluding learning period) or more from the date of advertisement of vacancies and wishes to appear in the driving test for award of marks.

- (i) Those candidates who possesses valid Heavy Vehicles Driving license and pass Heavy Vehicle driving test, shall be awarded 05 Marks. Those candidates who have the valid Light Vehicle Driving license and pass Light Vehicle Driving test shall be awarded 3 Marks, of those appearing for the test and awarded the marks shall be deemed to have accepted the service condition that if called upon they shall have to drive the light or heavy vehicle, as the case may be, as part of their normal duties and responsibilities.

Note.- Candidate must produce the valid original driving license, which must tally with the details given by him in the Application Form.

a) Written Test shall consist of multiple choice questions in Odia language, English language, Arithmetics, General Knowledge, Aptitude and Logical Reasoning etc.. The standard of the questions shall be such that a student who have passed +2 examination is able to answer the questions.

b) The candidates not appearing in written test shall be disqualified.

c) The examination shall be conducted using OMR method.

d) Selection Board will decide the minimum qualifying marks in the Written Test.

16. Medical Examination

A Medical Board comprising of two Doctors one of whom shall be a lady Doctor. One of the doctors who will head the Board shall be in the rank of SDMO or above. Medical test shall be conducted at any stage of recruitment process as scheduled by the Board. Following shall be specification for medical examination.

Candidates must not have knock knees, bow legs, flat foot, varicose veins, squint in eyes, poor vision, colour blindness, inability to flex the fingers properly and any other obvious deformities. He should have no impediment in speech and hearing.

The applicants shall produce a self certificate regarding his/her physical fitness declaring that he/she is fit to participate in different physical efficiency tests and submit it to the recruiting Board while appearing for the physical tests.
